







#### 100 Montana Students Awarded Youth Serve Scholarships

The Montana Campus Compact, Serve Montana and Reach Higher Montana are excited to announce that 100 incoming college freshmen will receive the prestigious Youth Serve Montana Scholarship. The scholarship was created to promote volunteerism among high school students, encourage young leaders to further their learning, and provide tuition assistance for Montana students attending college in-state at a Montana Campus Compact. Selected students receive a \$1,000 scholarship toward their college tuition.

Scholarship funds have been made available through support from <u>Reach Higher Montana</u>, a nonprofit dedicated to helping students pursue and fund post secondary education; and the <u>Governor's Office of Community Service</u>, a state agency tasked with expanding and promoting service in Montana. It will also provide opportunities to engage in ongoing professional development activities that foster reflective, inclusive, and equity-focused partnerships and commitments.

Professionals will be able to earn a variety of micro-credentials by submitting evidence that they have achieved competency in that area. Ultimately, the Community Engagement Certification will be made up of 14 micro-credentials.


