As an MTCC AmeriCorps VISTA, you have several options for reporting sexual harassment.

MTCC encourages you to familiarize yourself with your host site's sexual harassment policy as they may be your first avenue for reporting.

From CNCS: The Corporation for National and Community Service expects all program leaders and grantees to create safe service environments for our members. If members or volunteers believe that they are experiencing harassment, discrimination, or other safety and security issues, CNCS is committed to working with respective program leadership to address and assist in resolving these concerns as quickly as possible. CNCS has zero tolerance for harassment.

If your safety or security has been threatened in an AmeriCorps or Senior Corps program, it is important to report the incident to appropriate program leaders and sponsor supervisors. For sexual assault, contact local law enforcement authorities by calling 911.
